## Summary Report 2016-2020

## I. Main activities

- 1. Terminology & Standards initiative with a wiki-like Internet Platform (2017) with more than 200 checked and referenced terms used in ST & T;
- 2. Renewed Outcropedia portal (2018) with nearly 800 photos of the best outcrops in the world subdivided into 15 categories;
- 3. Monthly world Web Cast seminars on Structural Geology and Tectonics uploaded to the TecTask YouTube channel (started in 2018) with 19 online seminars, more than 600 subscribers and more than 18,000 total views;
- 4. TecTask meeting May 2019, Torino (Italy) to check the status of TT and to discuss the future directions of the commission;

5. Major contributor and player at the 2020 IGC in Delhi. TT proposed the theme 27 "ROCK DEFORMATION AND RHEOLOGY" with 6 symposia with nearly 170 abstracts accepted, TT is actively involved in theme 11 "THE HIMALAYA – ANATOMY OF AN EVOLVING MOUNTAIN CHAIN" with more than 180 abstracts accepted (before the conference was postponed). TT officers are involved in key note, symposia and in a Plenary Talk delivery (B. Hobbs).
