You will probably also recall that the IUGS Statutes and Byelaws will be revised accordingly. This work is now under progress.

IGCP

In February there were meetings between IUGS and UNESCO about the new guidelines for IGCP. It was agreed to focus on society-relevant themes, but still to give room for fundamental science research. The Scientific Board will be different from the previous structure, with fewer members meeting in Paris each year. There is now a close collaboration between IUGS, UNESCO and the IGCP Scientific Board in order to complete a new set of guidelines for project proposals at the end of April. Invitations for new proposals will be announced around the middle of 2006.
